Unless otherwise noted, these scholarships may be combined and awarded up to \$2,000 per year for in-state residents and \$600 per year for in-district residents. **NOTE:** Some scholarships exceed these limits and will not be offered in conjunction with other scholarship awards, unless otherwise noted.

Required Documents

- A high school **transcript** (GED certificate is acceptable on applicable scholarships). Transfer students may attach a transcript from previous college(s) attended.
- An **essay** (typewritten, two pages maximum) describing your college and career goals and why you feel you would be a worthy recipient. Be sure to include any information about your involvement in school/community activities (clubs, sports, music, drama, etc.), as well as special honors.
