Qualified applicants will be considered for all types of financial aid available from CNCC. This includes the Federal Pell Grant, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Federal College Work-study, Federal Perkins Loan, Colorado Grant, Colorado Governor's Opportunity Scholarship, Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership Program, Colorado Work-study, Institutional Grant, and Institutional Work-study. Financial aid, consisting of a combination of loan, work-study, grants and scholarships, is awarded on the basis of documented need. Financial need equals the established cost of attendance minus expected resources. If you have questions concerning your application or the financial aid process, do not hesitate to contact the Financial Aid Office. We are here to assist you.

APPLICATION FORMS - The following forms must be completed:

1. **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – Must be completed to be considered for Federal and State Aid!**
2. CNCC Financial Aid Student Information Form (on reverse side).
3. Application for Admission to CNCC.
4. You must be in a qualified degree or certificate program.

APPLICATION DATES – **Priority date: May 1st** (the FAFSA, including appropriate accompanying documentation, must be in final form in the Office of Financial Aid). After May 1st, funds are awarded on a first come-first serve basis as files are completed, as long as funds are available. **Financial aid awards are not automatically renewed – students must reapply on an annual basis.**

DAYCARE NEEDS - If you have children under the age of 13, it may be necessary for you to utilize a daycare center. You should submit a signed statement from your daycare provider to verify your monthly expenses due to time spent in classes. Without such documentation, we will be unable to make allowances for these expenses.

CHANGES - Students must notify the Office of Financial Aid immediately of any change in their financial situation, including the receipt of scholarships, marital status, residency status, class standing or any other factors that would have a bearing on their financial aid award.

CREDIT LOADS - Aid applicants generally will be required to enroll for and satisfactorily complete 12 credits per semester if full-time, 9-11 credits per semester if three-quarter time, 6-8 credits per semester if half-time and 1-5 credits per semester if less than half-time, exclusive of credits received by "testing out" of a class. See catalog for complete description.

VERIFICATION - You may be requested to verify certain information you provided on your FAFSA. Students asked to provide additional documentation will not be considered for aid until the verification process is complete. The types of additional documentation include but are not limited to tax returns (both parent and student), divorce decrees, and financial statements.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – You should visit the Financial Aid web page at www.cncc.edu/financial_aid/default and read the Handbook and related policies and procedures. Informational links for other helpful financial aid sites are also available from our site.

All financial aid awards are contingent upon the availability of funds, matriculation at CNCC, and subject to revision at any time. The college reserves the right to review and cancel the financial aid awards at any time because of changes in financial, residence, class standing, marital or academic status, or because of the recipient's failure to maintain satisfactory academic progress. From time to time, it becomes necessary for various reasons to change the specific guidelines and requirements for any given award.
