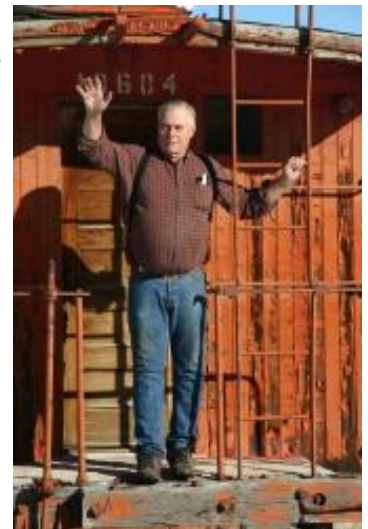
About CNCC’s Maybell Adventure Day Trips:

Our learning adventures take students back in time this summer as we explore Northwest Colorado with instructor, Lou Wyman, long-time rancher and founder of Wyman’s Museum. Lou’s family settled in Moffat County in 1900 and over the years Wyman’s ranching operations ran stock from Elk Springs to William’s Fork. The youngest son of a legendary rancher, Lou jokes that his father decided to have him late in life so that he would have someone to open gates for him. As father and son traveled the country, Lou’s father told him numerous historical accounts and stories, many of which will be shared as we reflect on the days of homesteading and the Meeker Massacre.
