

CNCC COVID Safety Reminders

General Safety

- **Face Coverings Required** in Common/Public Areas
 - Face coverings will be available at entrances to residence halls or upon request
 - **Face Coverings are required inside CNCC buildings at ALL Times**
- **Practice Good Hygiene** – Wash hands with soap, refrain from touching your face, and sanitize commonly touched surfaces.
- **Social Distancing** – Keep 6 Ft Apart Where Possible
- **Social Gatherings:** Gathering will be limited in size, based on overall square footage of the room/space per the State of CO COVID requirements.
- **Hand Sanitizer Stations** – Located at main entrance of the building, and hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building.
- **Signage**
 - Signs will be posted around campus to encourage social distancing and the use of face coverings, and to practice good personal hygiene
 - Signs will be posted on entrances reminding people not to enter if they feel ill or are exhibiting any other COVID like symptoms.

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

Fever or chills	Cough	Short of breath/difficulty breathing
Fatigue	Muscle or body aches	Headache
New loss of taste or smell	Sore throat	Congestion or runny nose
Nausea or vomiting	Diarrhea	Blush lips or face
Trouble breathing	Loss of Appetite or food not tasting good	New confusion
Persistent pain/pressure in the chest	Inability to wake or stay awake
