Terms and Conditions

1. Student must declare intent to participate in the program by submitting a Guaranteed Admission Program Application declaring a one or two year rollout to the Nursing Program Coordinator by August 1st of the year prior to beginning the Guaranteed Admission program at CNCC.
2. Student must demonstrate college readiness in English, Math and Reading through placement testing (Accuplacer, ACT or SAT) to be eligible for participation in the Guaranteed Admission Program.
3. Guaranteed admission into CNCC's Nursing Program is dependent upon an earned grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on all five (5) prerequisite courses. A grade of "C" in any required pre-requisite course is acceptable if GPA remains at a minimum of 3.0. Students must pass and complete every course they are registered for while in the GA program. Classes may not be repeated to receive a higher grade. A received grade of a "D" or "F" will result in automatic dismissal from the guaranteed admissions program and automatically move to competitive entry. A withdrawal (W) or an administrative drop (AD) is equivalent to a failure. All classes must be completed and meet these standards by the end of the spring semester preceding admission to the Nursing Program.
4. All five (5) prerequisite courses for the Guaranteed Admission courses must be completed at a CNCC campus (Craig, Rangely, Concurrent). Other general education courses applicable to the AAS in Nursing may be taken through CNCC in-person, hybrid or virtual delivery. No online courses will be accepted. No transfer credits will be accepted into the Guaranteed Admission program.
5. Students in the GA Program must take the TEAS test prior to admission into the CNCC Nursing Program. Students must receive a score of proficient or better on the TEAS test administered by ATI. TEAS score must have been received within the 12 months preceding admission into the CNCC Nursing Program.
6. Students must be in good academic standing to be admitted to the Nursing Program. Any form of academic disciplinary action will result in loss of position in the GA Nursing Program.
7. A student who fails to meet terms and conditions will not be guaranteed admission; however, the student may apply to the CNCC Nursing program through the general application process and compete with other applicants for a position in the program.
